By the end of Y6, we want children at Stadhampton Primary School to:

- **Communication** - Be able to communicate effectively in a range of situations.
- **Lexicogrammar** - Use vocabulary and grammar correctly and understand that they are interdependent. Utilise their prior knowledge to further explore and create new sentences and phrases.
- **Cultural Awareness** - Recognise and be able to talk about the similarities/differences between their country and Spanish-speaking countries through research and activities related to a variety of important cultural events and traditions.
- **Phonics** - Apply their knowledge of Spanish phonics (different phonemes/graphemes) to communicate accurately.
- **Love for languages** - Have developed an interest in/understanding of MFLs.
