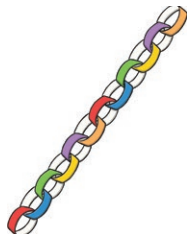
Reading Tricky Words

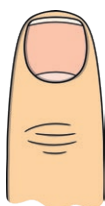
