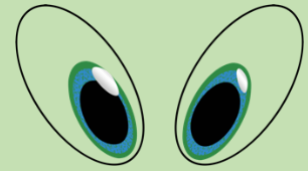




Peek at the week

This week

Phonics:

Level 1/2 – taking part in singing songs and rhymes, listening to, and following instructions.

Maths:

Having learnt about morning, afternoon, evening, night, and days of the week last week we move on to finding out about maps, what we use them for and the different types available. We will be making maps of our classroom and seeing how to get to different areas of the school. We will also use the compass in the playground to find another way of navigating.

Topic:

Our topic this half term is 'All about me', last week we talked about members of our families and this week it is who is in our class, making sure we all know each other's names. We will also be thinking about who's who in the wider school. Lots more exploring the school this week.

Art – we start by looking at the artwork of Yayoi Kusama this week and seeing what she used to make her pieces of art.

Cultural Capital – our landmark this week is Stonehenge.
