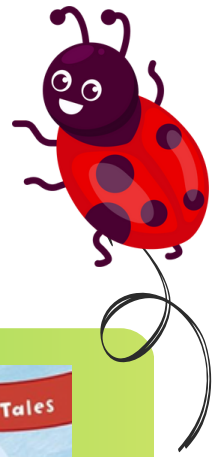




LADYBIRD CLASS

This week's learning

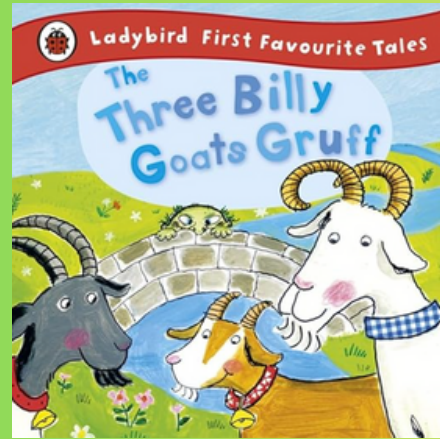
Phonics - our phonemes for this week are t and p, a review of satp and an introduction to i.
