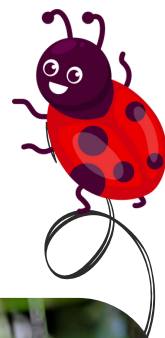

The bookmarks will be in book bags at the end of a set of phonemes. The first one will be in bags at the end of this week.



### **This week's learning**

**Phonics** - our phonemes for this week are from set 4 - e, u and r. Our tricky words are - the, to.

**Maths** - Block 4 - circles and triangles. We find out about the simple properties of these shapes so we can identify circles and triangles from a group of shapes.

**Literacy** - It is World Nursery Rhyme week this week and we will be taking part in the same activities children around the world who are taking part will be doing. The nursery rhymes for this year are - Humpty Dumpty, Sing a song of sixpence, I hear thunder and When I was one. There is also Two little dickie birds but we are on our trip on Friday, if you have the opportunity to sing this with your child that would be great.
