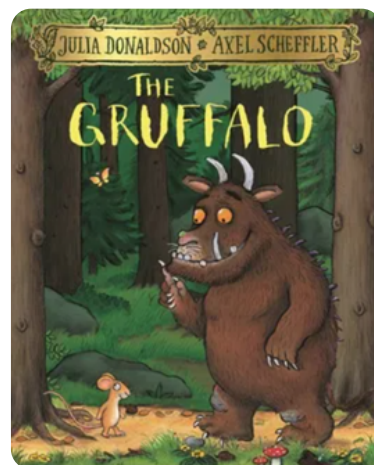
## This week's learning

**Phonics** - our phonemes for this week are from set 5, they are f, l and a recap of all 4 sounds. . Our tricky words are - no, go, l.

**Maths** - Block 5 - 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. This week we look closely at 1 more and 1 less for numbers to 5.

**Literacy** - Our book this week is 'How to count to one' by Caspar Salmon and Matt Hunt. A humorous look at counting.

**Science** - Last week the children asked some very interesting questions about space, we will talking about the answers to them along with thinking about the changing seasons and what we might see as winter takes hold.
