This week's learning

Phonics - we have now finished all the new sounds in Level 2. This week we look at the sounds ff, ll, ss which still make the same sound as their single letters and also 's' when it is at the end of a word like pigs and so makes a 'z' sound. We will continue to recall our tricky words - to, the, no, go, i.

Maths - Block 6 - shapes with 4 sides. We have looked at circles and triangles and this week our attention turns to squares and rectangles.

Literacy - Our book this week is 'Space Tortoise' by Ross Montgomery and David Litchfield. It is all about a tortoise who wonders if all the other animals are in space and so decides to travel there in a homemade hot air balloon.

Cutting skills - we will be focusing on our cutting skills this week - if you have the opportunity to support your child at home with their cutting skills that would be very helpful. We find that children unable to cut find many of the creative tasks very frustrating.



SCIENCE

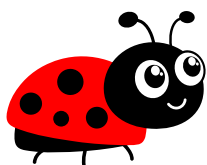
- Our topic for the next few weeks is 'What's changed'.
