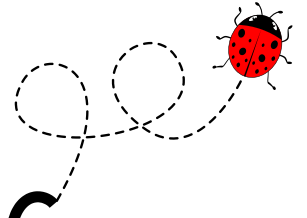

This week's learning

Phonics - We have now started Level 3. Our sounds this week are y, z, zz, qu, ch and our new tricky words are he, she. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

Maths - Our current maths topic is 'Alive in 5' - in it we look at zero to 5, finding 1 more or less and subitising numbers to 5.

Literacy - Our book this week is 'Pigs might fly' by Jonathan Emmett and Steve Cox. It is the story of the three little pigs in a flying competition with the wolf. The prize - all the pies they can eat! The pigs and the wolf both want to build and fly the best plane - who will win?



TOPIC

- Our topic this half term is called 'Once upon a time - What can we learn from stories?' The stories we will use are traditional tales - we will explore what stories these are, the characters in them, differences and similarities. We will also be thinking about the way the characters behave and what we can learn from the stories.
