SCIENCE - UTW

- Over the next few weeks we will be exploring pushing and pulling.
- We start by looking at forces in general and then next week carry out our own investigation on pushing or pulling different objects.
- You could try an investigation of your own at home - how many things need pushing or pulling - which one do we do more of. I would love to hear about it on Tapestry.

This week's learning

Phonics - Level 3 - Our sounds this week are sh, th (unvoiced as in moth), th (voiced as in feather) and ng, and our new tricky words - we, me, be. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

Maths - our maths this week is Mass and Capacity. We will be exploring a set of scales and seeing when and why they balance, and also finding out about the capacity of containers.

Literacy - Our book this week is 'Meet the Weather' a non-fiction book that uses poems to explore different types of weather. We will also use the book to think about the differences between fiction and non-fiction writing.
