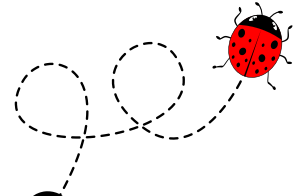

This week's learning

Phonics - Level 3 - Our sounds this week are ai as in rain or snail and ee as in sheep and tree, and our new tricky word - was - we talked about how the word can't be sounded out and that learning it for reading is easier than learning to spell it. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

Maths - our maths this week is based on the numbers 6, 7, 8, we will be fully exploring them over the next two weeks - this week thinking about how they are represented using a 10s frame and that they are made up of 5 and 1, 2, or 3 more.

Literacy - Our book this week is 'The Proudest Blue' a fiction book that explores how Asiya feels strong and proud when she gets her first hijab and how others treat her, told through the eyes of her younger sister Faziah.

Handwriting - we are now focusing daily on handwriting. We started with letters in the curly caterpillar family, these are a, c, d, e, f, g, o, q, s. We are on our last set this week - o, g and q.

SCIENCE - UTW

- Over the next few weeks we will be exploring pushing and pulling.
- We start by looking at forces in general and then next week carry out our own investigation on pushing or pulling different objects.
