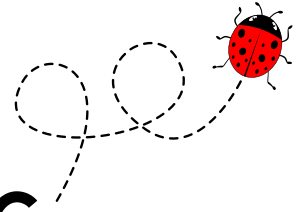

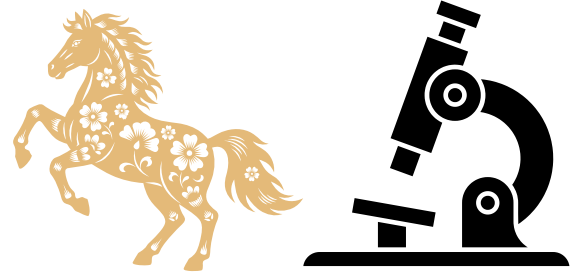
### This week's learning

**Phonics** - Level 3 - Our sounds this week are igh as in night and oa as in boat, and our new tricky word - my. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

**Maths** - our maths this week is based on the numbers 6, 7, 8, we continue to fully exploring the numbers - this week thinking about odd and even numbers and doubling numbers to 5 - at this stage we focus on the concept of doubling and so only use the numbers 1-5.

**Literacy** - Our book this week is 'Bear Shaped' a fiction book that explores what happens when a young boy loses his favourite teddy. The book is based on a true story.

**Handwriting**- we are now focusing daily on handwriting. We have now finished learning the formation of the curly caterpillar letters and so are moving on to those in the long ladder family - we start this week with the letters i, l, t, u, y - these letters all start at the top of their letter shape. If children are writing at home please try to ensure they are forming them correctly - bad habits are difficult to change.



### TOPIC

- UTW - The Natural World - we have the opportunity to investigate what we can see when we use a microscope. We will look at a range of slides that have been prepared for us.
- UTW - People and Communities - Chinese New Year. We will look at the festival celebrated by the Chinese community.
