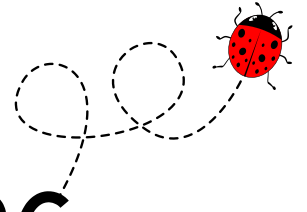

Phonics - Level 3 - Our sounds this week are /or/ as in corn, thorn and /ur/ as in surf, curl, our new tricky word is they. Maths - Building 9 & 10 is our maths learning this week. We will be looking at identifying the numbers, comparing numbers and representing the numbers 9 & 10.

Literacy - our book this week is Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne - the story of Handa's journey to see her friend Akeyo with a basket of fruit.

Handwriting- we are learning our final family of letters over the next two weeks - one armed robots - we focus this week on the letters r, m, n, b and h.

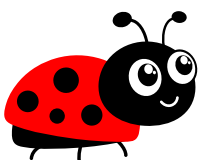
