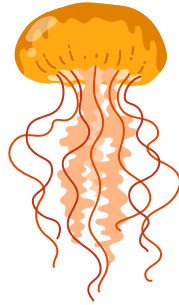
This week's learning

Phonics - Level 3 - Our sounds this week are /ure/ as in pure, secure and /er/ as in pepper, summer - one trigraph and one digraph. We will be revisiting all the tricky words from Level 3 this week. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website. Please look in book bags this week for new bookmarks with words to practice reading at home, thank you.

Maths - Building 9 & 10 - this is a large topic because there is a lot to learn about 10. This week we look again at doubles - finding and making them and further explore odd and even numbers. Helping your child recognise a number as odd or even is a great activity - can they tell you why it is odd or even. We have only looked at numbers to 10 so far.

Literacy - Our book this week is 'If sharks disappeared' - what would happen to our oceans if they became too polluted and there were no longer any sharks!

Handwriting - Our focus this week is capital letters - we will do A to O. We will continue to look at letter formation through our writing.



OUR TOPIC LEARNING

- We will continue to look at question words - who, what, where, when, why and how. We have thought very carefully about questions we could ask rather than statements or facts we might give.
- For our topic on animals we will look at ways we can sort them - what characteristics might we consider when we put the animals in groups? Where they live? Do they have feathers? When do they sleep?
