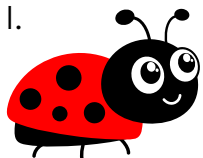
## This week's learning

**Phonics** - Level 4 continues this week, we will be reading words that have adjacent consonants at the beginning - frog, stop, swim. To ensure the children are able to fully grasp the concepts of level 4, we are taking two weeks to complete each week of the level 4 program. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

**Maths** - This week our block is - How many more? We are thinking about addition and subtraction.

**Literacy** - Our book this week is called 'Katie and the Sunflowers'. Katie enjoys visiting art galleries with her grandmother but each time something happens with one of the pictures! Quite an adventure for Katie.

**Handwriting**- During handwriting we are completing dictation sentences, so we can focus on letter formation, phonic knowledge and sentence writing skills. We will also focus on small words that we use regularly in our writing, words like - it, is, the, to, no, go, I.

- We continue our topic on growing with a look at the parts of a plant. What do the different parts do?
