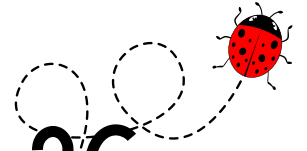

This week's learning

Phonics - Level 4 continues this week, we will be reading words that have adjacent consonants at the beginning - frog, stop, swim. To ensure the children are able to fully grasp the concepts of level 4, we are taking two weeks to complete each week of the level 4 program. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

Maths - A new area of learning this week - Manipulate, compose and decompose - we will be exploring shapes and how their properties help when using them to create pictures.

Literacy - Our book this week is called 'Jack and the Jellybean Stalk'. Jack gets jellybeans when he goes to market to sell his cow - I am sure you can guess what happens next!

Handwriting- During handwriting we will be practising letter formation through writing captions and sentences about a picture.



OUR TOPIC LEARNING

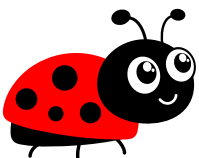
