## This week's learning

**Phonics** - Level 4 continues this week, we will be reading words that have adjacent consonants anywhere in the word - our adventure with Kit and Sam takes us on a camping trip. To ensure the children are able to fully grasp the concepts of level 4, we are taking two weeks to complete each week of the level 4 program. **Maths** - Week 2 of Manipulate, compose and decompose - we will be exploring shapes, what shapes we can see in other shapes and making patterns.

**Literacy** - Our book this week is called 'The Giant Jam Sandwich', when a swarm of wasps descend on a village, the villagers come up with an ingenious plan to deal with them!

**Handwriting**- During handwriting we will be practising letter formation through writing captions and sentences about a picture.
