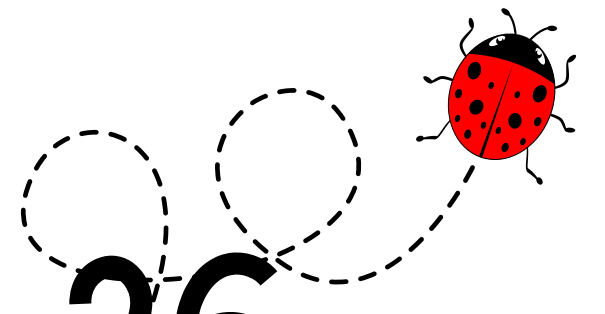

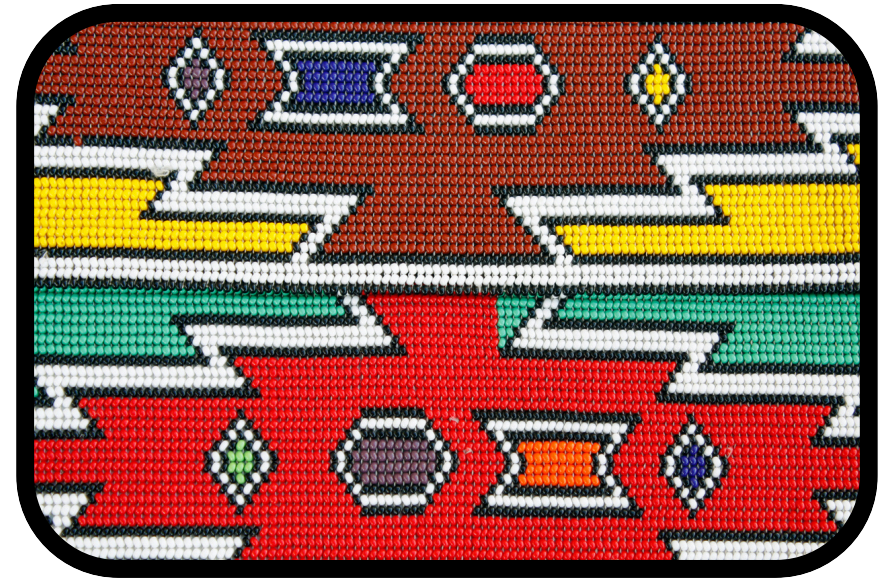
### This week's learning

**Phonics** - We will finish Week 4, Level 4 this week and continue with Week 5. You will find accompanying sheets on the Ladybird page of the school website.

**Maths** - Week 3 of sharing and group, we are continuing this concept area as there is so much to learn. This week our focus will still be grouping and what happens when we try to group odd and even numbers. We will also recall doubles and have a look at a half of a number, finding out how they are linked.

**Literacy** - Our book this week is called 'Sam and Dave dig a hole' - the story of two boys who decide to dig a hole. It is a story book that uses the pictures to really bring the story to life. What will Sam and Dave find when they start digging?

**Handwriting**- During handwriting we will be practising letter formation by revisiting letters in the one-armed robot family, these are the letters - b, h, k, n, m, p, r.

- It is art week and the focus in Ladybird Class will be Ndebele patterns and art work.
