awful **yawn** **straw**



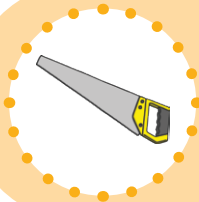

au saying /or/ as in **autumn**.



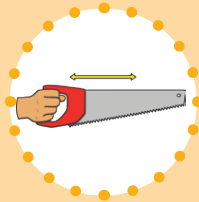

Can you use **and** to join the two sentences below?

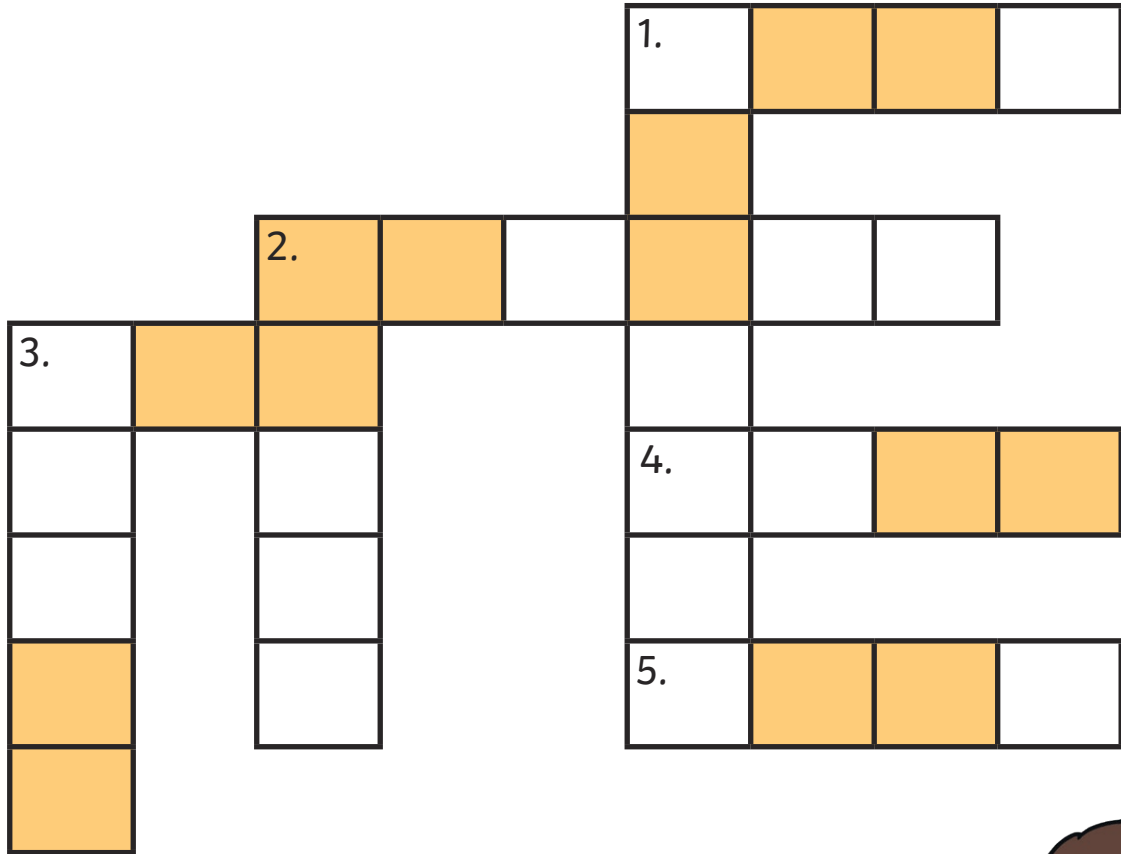
Dawn is an astronaut.
