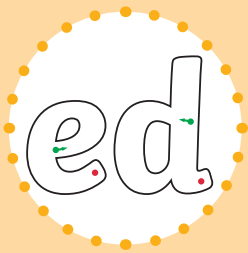
-ed

This word ending can be added to the end of a root 'doing word'. It changes the doing word (verb) from present tense to past tense.

For example:

jump becomes **jumped**.

gasp becomes **gasp****ed**.

Grammar

This week, we revisited using exclamation marks and question marks in our writing. We learnt when a sentence needs a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark.



Dad reminds us that sometimes we need to use a question mark to finish our sentence and show that it is a question.



Ben reminds us that sometimes we might want to use an exclamation mark to finish our sentence.

- We know that a sentence can end in a **full stop**.
- We also know that when a sentence is a question, we use a **question mark** at the end.
- When we want to add feeling to our writing, we can use an **exclamation mark**.
- An exclamation mark is used to express a strong feeling, such as excitement, surprise, anger or joy.

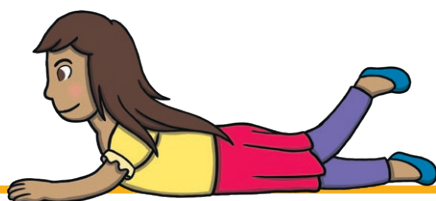
