



EYFS - Learning how to be at school. What are the rules? How do I need to behave in places around the school? Who are my new friends?

Year 1 - What makes me special? Talking about my feelings and what makes me happy or sad or cross and what I do when I feel like that.

EYFS - Settling in activities - learning how to talk to new friends, routines and the associated language.

Year 1 - A key part of the skills needed to be a good learner is knowing when it is time for a discussion and when to be a good listener.

EYFS - Funky fingers time uses activities like threading, pattern making, using scissors or tweezers - building muscles ready for pencil control. Forest School supports gross motor skills.

Year 1 - Fine motor skill development is through funky fingers and handwriting. Gross motor skills - Forest School and fundamental PE skills.

PSED/PSHE
In this area of our curriculum we focus on learning how to regulate our behaviour, make friends and manage ourselves.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE
In this area of the curriculum we think about the skills of listening, understanding, attention and speaking.

PD/PE
In this area of the curriculum we develop gross and fine motor skills. Fine motor skill development is through funky finger activities and gross through PE style tasks.

WELCOME
This is our curriculum document for the first half of the autumn term. You will find headline information about the concepts and skills being learnt. For further information please look at 'Peek at the week'.



UTW/TOPIC
In this area of the curriculum we focus on subjects such as history, geography, computing, RE, science and cultural capital.

LITERACY
This is the area of the curriculum where we develop reading through phonics and writing through spelling and the technical skills needed.

MATHS
We use the White Rose scheme to teach maths. The skills needed for maths throughout primary school and beyond are taught in a sequential way.

DT/MUSIC
For DT this half term our focus will be preparing a healthy snack for a child using seasonally available produce. Music focus - Everyday life ~ using rhythm.

HISTORY - The history of farming - how did we move from hunter gathers to farmers of today.
CULTURAL CAPITAL - Extraordinary musicians.
COMPUTING - Year 1 - Technology around us.

RE - People who are special to us.
SCIENCE - Humans, naming parts of our body, our senses and how we use them.

PHONICS -
EYFS ~ Level 1-2 - following on from previous learning.
Year 1 ~ Start level 5.

WRITING - Our weekly focus book will be on 'Peek at the week'. Handwriting - **EYFS** ~ basic mark making. **Year 1** ~ continuing to develop early letter formation.

EYFS - Matching and sorting, measures and patterns. A basic concept of maths is to be able to spot patterns, these units start building that skill.

Year 1 - The first block is place value. This includes further development of the skill of pattern spotting and developing a deeper understanding of numbers to 10.
