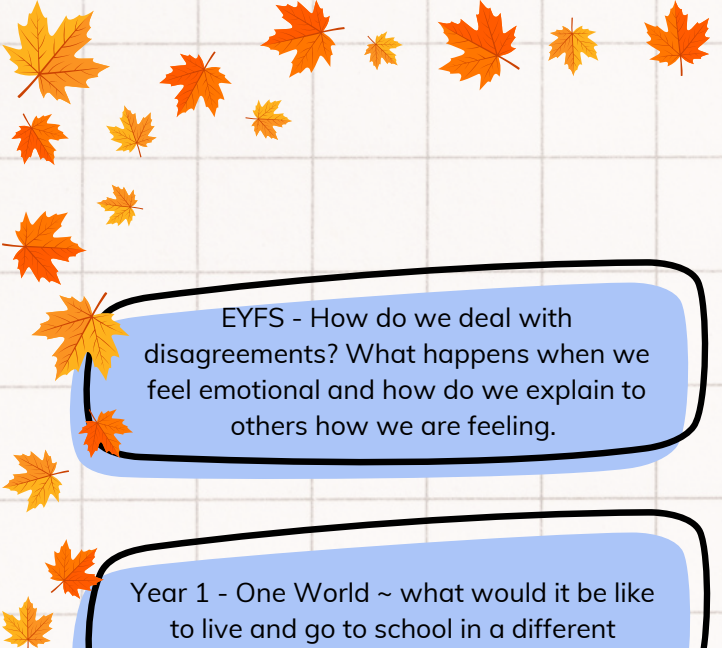




EYFS - How do we deal with disagreements? What happens when we feel emotional and how do we explain to others how we are feeling.

Year 1 - One World ~ what would it be like to live and go to school in a different country? Is everybody's home the same?

EYFS - Listening carefully, why it is important and how to listen. Listening and responding to new stories and vocabulary.

Year 1 - Oracy ~ what skills do we need to be a good orator and how do we develop them?

EYFS - Funky fingers time uses activities like threading, pattern making, using scissors or tweezers - building muscles ready for pencil control. Forest School supports gross motor skills.

Year 1 - Fine motor skill development is through funky fingers and handwriting. Gross motor skills - Forest School and ball skills in PE.

PSED/PSHE
In this area of our curriculum we focus on learning how to regulate our behaviour, make friends and manage ourselves.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE
In this area of the curriculum we think about the skills of listening, understanding, attention and speaking.

PD/PE
In this area of the curriculum we develop gross and fine motor skills. Fine motor skill development is through funky finger activities and gross through PE style tasks.

WELCOME

UTW/TOPIC
In this area of the curriculum we focus on subjects such as history, geography, computing, RE, science and cultural capital.

LITERACY
This is the area of the curriculum where we develop reading through phonics and writing through spelling and the technical skills needed.

MATHS
We use the White Rose scheme to teach maths. The skills needed for maths throughout primary school and beyond are taught in a sequential way.

DT/ART
We will focus on art this half term, exploring the artist Dame Zaha Hadid and the lines she uses. Our music focus is nursery rhymes.

GEOGRAPHY - Exploring the human and physical aspects of our local environment.
CULTURAL CAPITAL - Extraordinary sports people.
COMPUTING - Year 1 ~ Creating media, digital painting.

RE - Why is light important in religion?
SCIENCE - Seasonal changes - summer to autumn, day and night and nocturnal animals.

PHONICS -
EYFS ~ Level 2, looking at the most commonly used single sounds.
Year 1 ~ Moving through level 5.

WRITING - Our weekly focus book will be on 'Peek at the week'. Handwriting - **EYFS** ~ basic mark making. **Year 1** ~ continuing to develop early letter formation.

EYFS - Exploring the numbers to 1-5 ~ what do they look like, how can we represent them and what happens if we have 1 more or 1 less, as well as shapes.

Year 1 - Our focus is addition and subtraction within 10. We will ensuring we have a good understanding of the concepts as well developing our shape knowledge.
