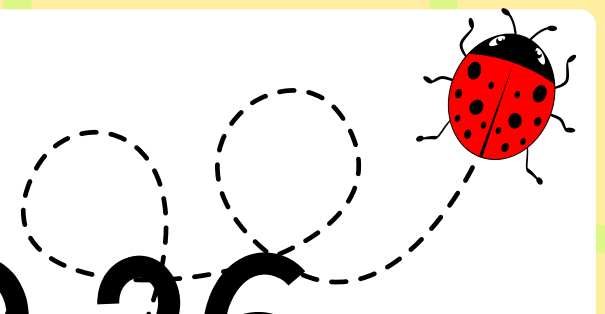

PEEK AT THE WEEK ~ 21.9.26

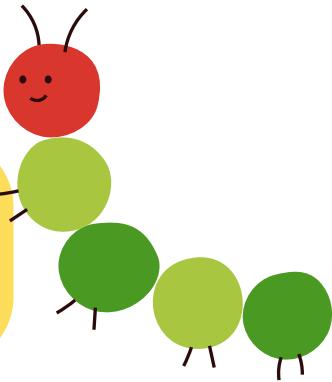
Hello!

OUR TOPIC LEARNING



- **History/UTW** - We looked at the lives of Stone Age people last week and this week we see the start of farming and the difference that made to people's lives.
- **Science/UTW** - We look at our senses this week - what are they and which part of our body do we use for each sense.
- **RE/UTW** - Kindness and caring - we will be thinking about the questions, how do we show kindness to others and why is it important to be kind.
- **Cultural Capital** - Our extraordinary musician this week is Aretha Franklin - The Queen of Soul.
- **Music** - Everyday Life - we are learning songs and listening to rhythm using activities we regularly take part in - like brushing our teeth or getting up in the morning.
- **Computing** - Yr1 only - How we log in to the computers and then perform a simple task of moving an object.

This week's learning

Phonics -

Reception - We continue with the development of phonological awareness skills - ensuring that we can tune in to sounds and identify what we are listening to.

Yr1 - Our focus this week is the grapheme -oy which makes the -oi sound as in - boy or toy.

Yr1 will receive spelling bookmarks this week - circled are the words we will focus on in our spelling sessions. Any opportunities you have to reinforce the words by reading them or ensuring they are spelt correctly in writing at home, would be very beneficial, thank you.

Maths -

Reception - We are still in the 'getting to know you' phase and our maths will be practical activities in the classroom.

Yr1 - We continue our look at place value, this week we are focusing on number tracks, finding 1 more or 1 less and learning to link number words with their number digit. We only look at numbers to 10.

Literacy/English - Our focus book this week is the very well known book - The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle. The story of the caterpillar who couldn't stop eating until they became a chrysalis and then a butterfly.

Handwriting -

Reception - using a pencil to draw simple images.

Yr1 - number formation - 5 to 9 this week.
